HANDICAP STROKE EVENT FOR WINNERS OF MONTHLY MEDALS JANUARY to DECEMBER 2013

HISTORY

The Ted Box Trophy was established in honour of Mr. Ted Box, President 1966-68 and elected Honorary Life Member in 1980. Following the death of Mr. Ted Box, his widow Mrs Ena Box presented Ted Box's monthly medals (Silver Spoons) to the Club. Purchase of the Silver Water Jug and mounting of the Medal Spoons was arranged by Brian Lamb. The first winner of the Ted Box Trophy was Mr. J B Dickson.

CONDITIONS OF COMPETITION.

1. The competition is open to winners of Monthly Medals in 2013 and will be played in accordance with the Rules of Golf and the Local Rules of Bowral Golf Club.
2. The standard Club ball competition (Peter Tait Trophy Round 2) will be run in conjunction with the Ted Box Trophy.
3. The standard entry fee will be charged.
4. Players will play off Club Handicaps (Max 36) applicable for the day.
5. In the case of a tie, the winner will be determined by count back.
6. The winner will have his name inscribed on the Honour Board and announced at the Club's Annual Presentation of Trophies Dinner. The winner and runner-up will each receive a voucher for entry and complimentary food for one at the Club's Annual "Presentation of Trophies" Dinner. The current holder is Pascal Timores.
